

Vittorio Erspamer Award

The *Vittorio Erspamer Award* is presented every two years in commemoration of *Vittorio Erspamer's* role in the study of the pharmacology of peptides and of diverse contributions he made to peptide science.

The Award is given to the scientist who made the most significant contribution to peptide science in the two years preceding the year of the Award.

The Award is restricted to scientist of Italian citizenship aged 40 or below. Also eligible are non-Italian citizens aged 40 or below, on condition that the work candidate for the Award was made in an Italian laboratory.

The members of the Council and the Scientific Committee of the ItPS shall be ineligible for the Award during their terms of Office.

Candidates for the Award must submit, within the term indicated on the ItPS web site: (i) A Curriculum vitae; (ii) A summary of the research conducted in the two years preceding the year of the Award; (iii) A maximum of five scientific papers published during the two years preceding the year of the Award.

The members of the ItPS Council and of the ItPS Scientific Committee will jointly review the candidates and assign the award.

The President of the ItPS Council will present the Award. In case of Sponsorship of the Award, a representative of the Sponsor will also present the Award.

The laureate(s) will receive a medal and will be invited, at the expense of the ItPS or, if present, the Sponsor, to give a lecture during a special ceremony at the opening of the biannual Meeting of the Italian Peptide Society.
