Vittorio Erspamer Award 2023

The **Vittorio Erspamer Award** is presented every two years in commemoration of Vittorio Erspamer's role in the Peptide Science. The Award is given to a young scientist of any nationality who has achieved significant results in Peptide Science. **The Award is restricted to scientists, members of the ItPS, aged 35 or under, at the application closing date** (see below), on the understanding that the research activity presented by the candidate must have been principally carried out in an Italian laboratory. The members of the Scientific Committee of the ItPS are ineligible for the Award during their terms of Office.

Candidates for the Award must submit, within the term indicated on the ItPS web site: (i) A Curriculum vitae; (ii) A summary of the research conducted in the **two years preceding the year of the Award**; (iii) **A maximum of five scientific papers published during the two years preceding the year of the Award**. The innovative aspects of the research and any contributions to Peptide Science must be underlined in the curriculum. Papers accepted for printing are admitted, provided that the journal's declaration of acceptance is attached. The members of the ItPS Scientific Committee will evaluate the candidates and propose the winner.

The documentation, in pdf format, must be attached to the **application form** (see template) and sent by e-mail to the ItPS secretariat (societaitalianapeptidi@gmail.com). Applications received after **May 31, 2023** will not be considered. **Applicants must not have turned 35 by that date.**

The awardee(s) will receive a plaque and a certificate, and will be invited to give a lecture during the "Giornata Scientifica" of the Italian Peptide Society.
